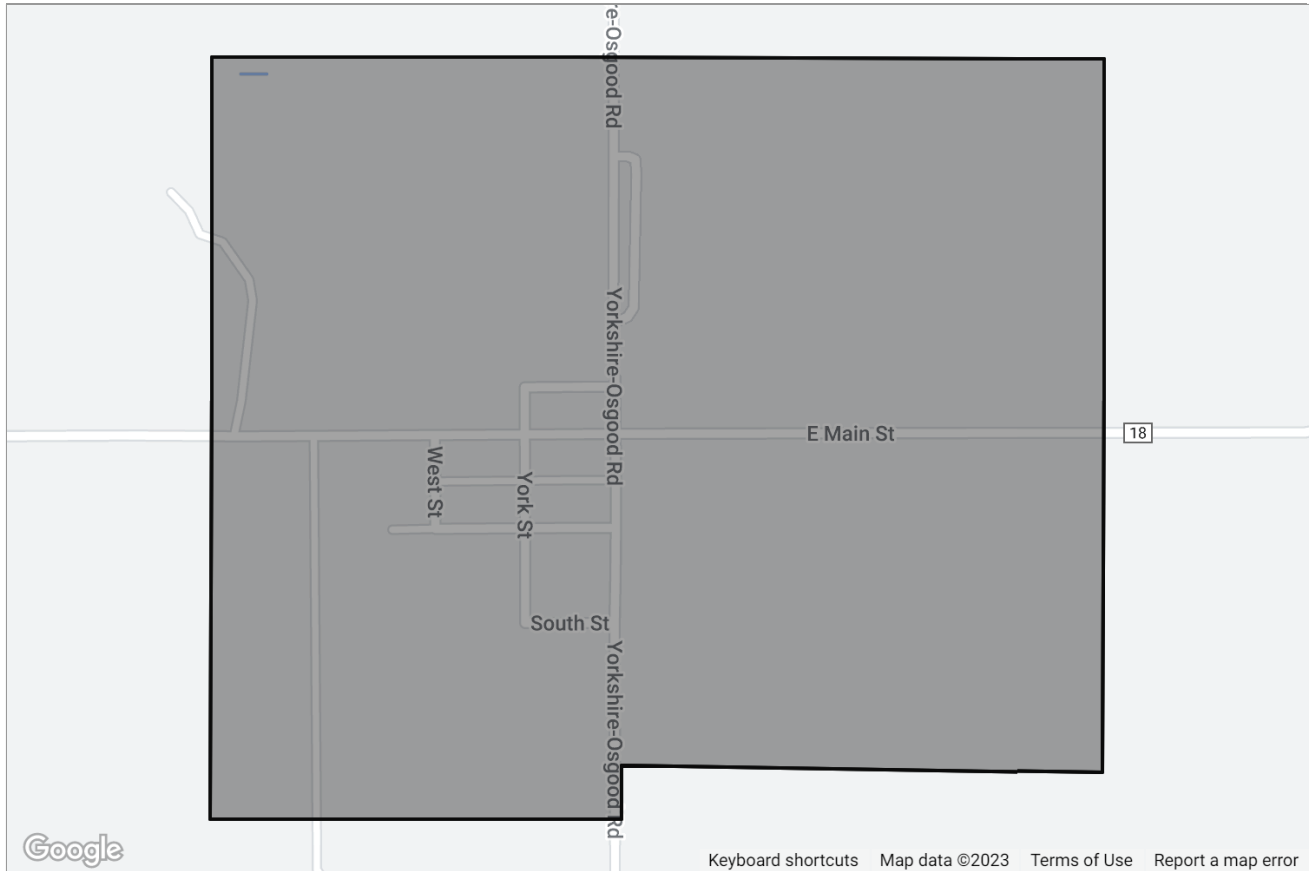

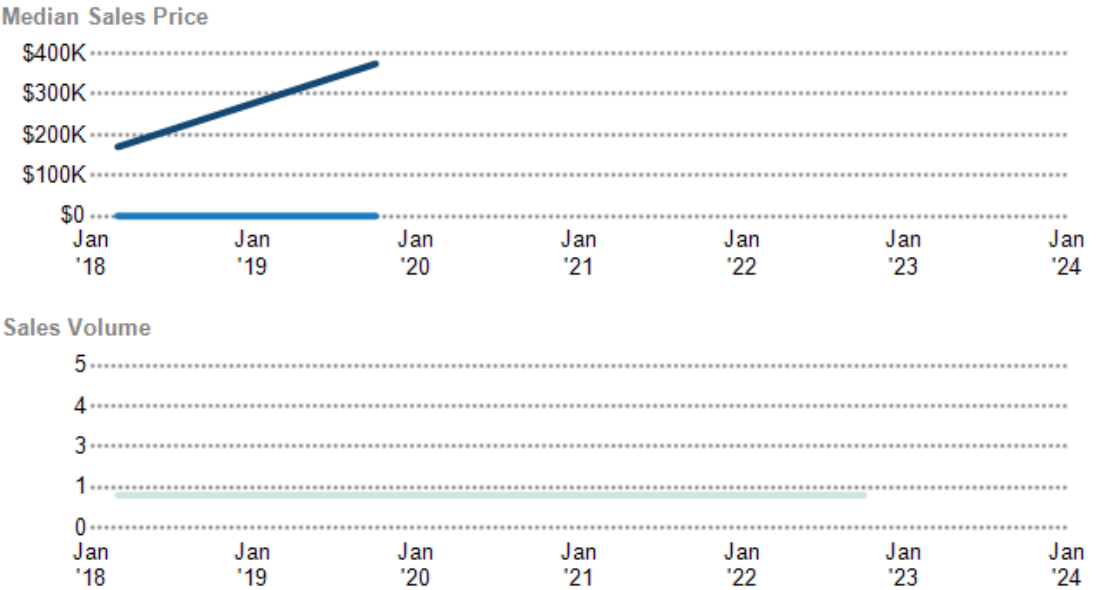

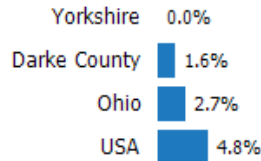

This chart shows the educational achievement levels of adults in an area, compared with other geographies.

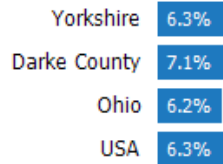

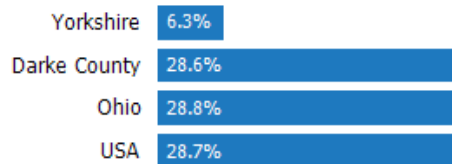

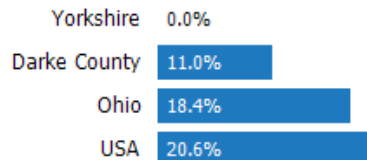

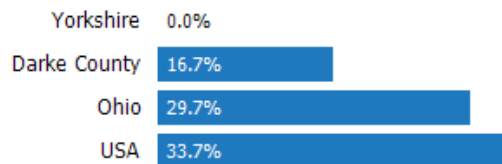

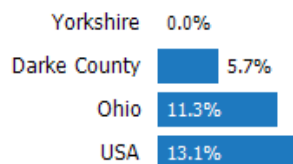

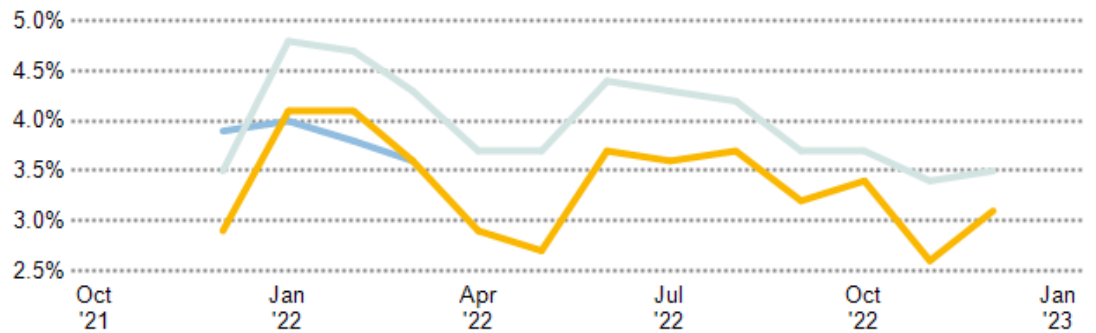

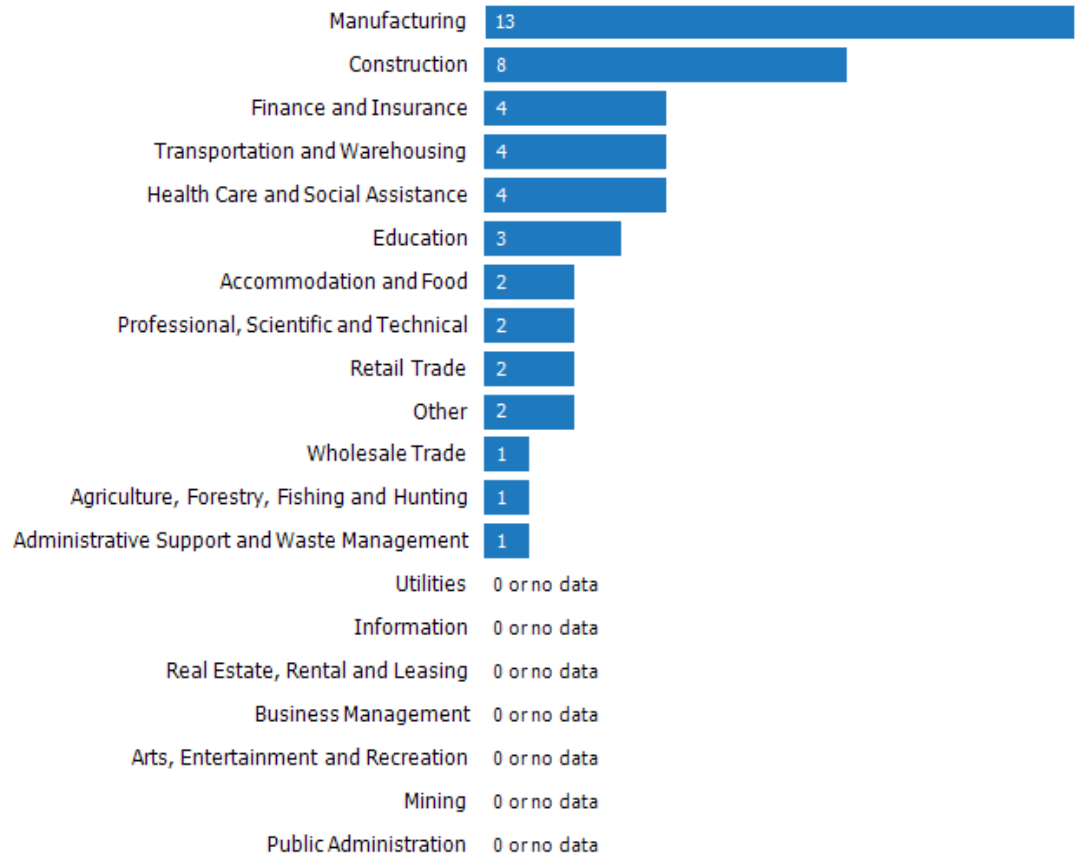
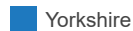


## Occupational Categories

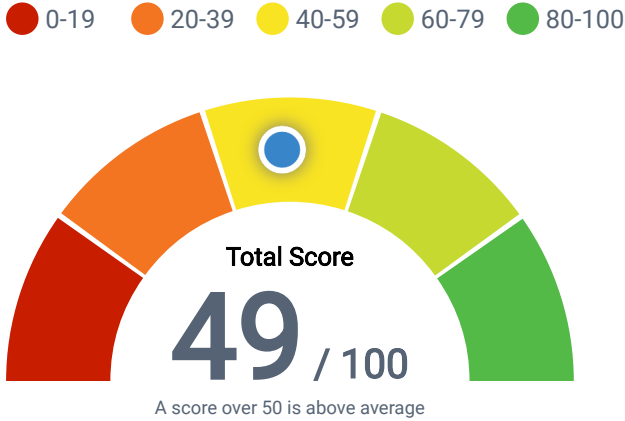


AARP Livability™ Index for 45388
