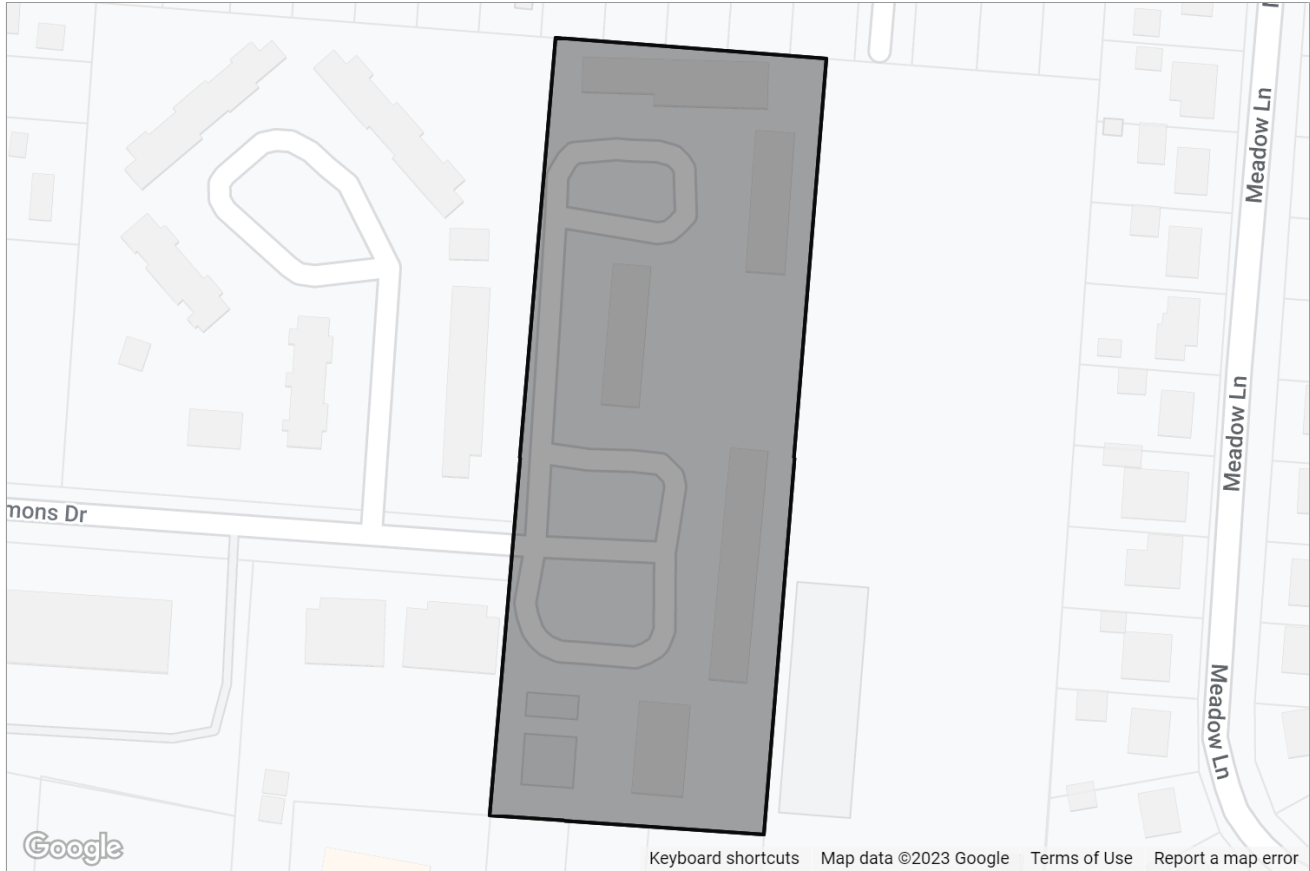

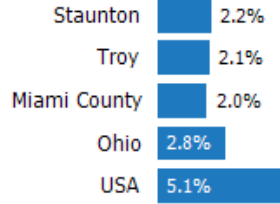
Education Levels of Population

This chart shows the educational achievement levels of adults in an area, compared with other geographies.

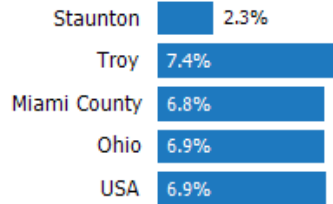

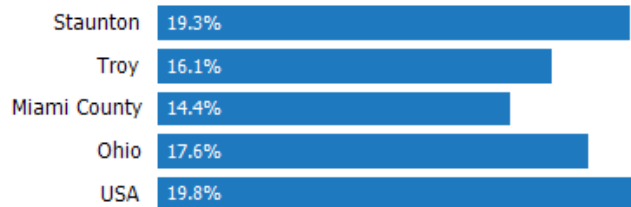

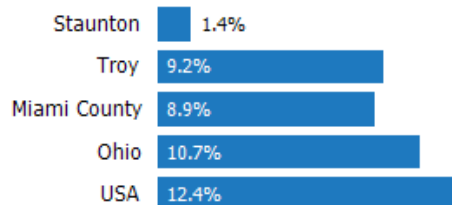

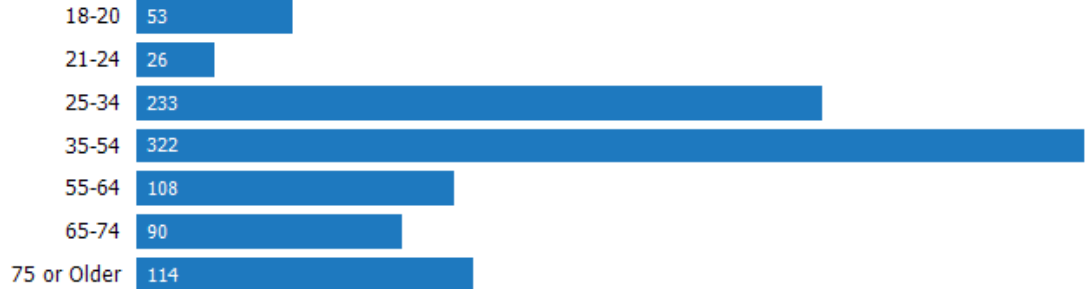
Population of Adults by Age Group

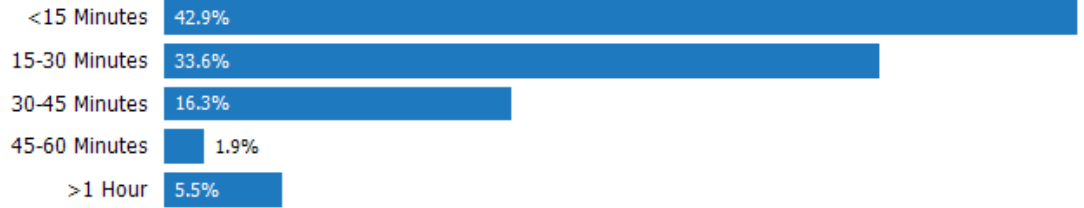

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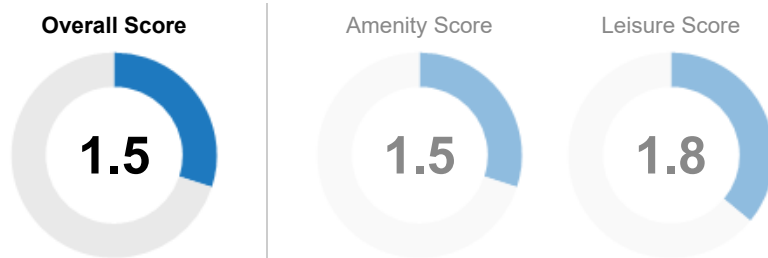
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Walkability Scores (out of 5)

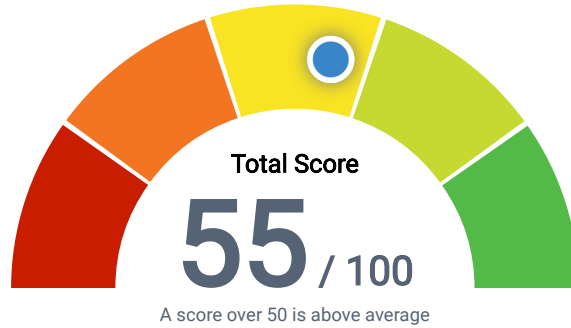


AARP Livability™ Index for 45373
